



Call Templates III (Nursery and Primary Schools)

Call No 02_20_080 – less developed regions

Call No 02_20_081 – more developed regions

What is the aim of the call?

The objective of the call is the development of nursery and primary schools through projects with simplified costs (so called templates). Supported activities are aimed at personnel support of the schools, organization of the project days, ICT support or at international study visits of the teachers.

Parallel implementation of the projects from Templates II and III

Due to the extraordinary situation and the possible extension of the implementation of projects from the second phase of templates, there may be a partial parallel implementation of projects from Templates II and III. This is possible under the condition that the projects will not include the same activities implemented at the same time.

What is the amount of financial support?

- Allocation for the call: **3 billion CZK**
 - Less developed regions: CZK 2 730 000 000
 - More developed region: CZK 270 000 000
- The minimum amount of total eligible expenditure: CZK 100 000
- The maximum amount of total eligible expenditure: CZK 200 000 per nursery/primary school + (number of children/pupils x CZK 1 500); it may not exceed CZK 5 million per applicant at the same time
- Beneficiary co-financing rate: 0 %

How and when to apply?

Grant applications are submitted through IS KP14+ (<https://mseu.mssf.cz>) **in the period from 31.03.2020 until the allocation is exhausted, at latest till 29.06.2021, 14:00.**

What activities are eligible?

Obligatory activity (for both nursery and primary schools):

- Project day in teaching
- A template due to the results of questionnaire survey

Support of ICT education

- The aim of the template is to improve teaching through ICT technologies, including the possibility of purchasing tablets or laptops and their long-term use in teaching.
- The template contains several versions due to the project duration - the school will receive funding for the implementation of the template and the purchase of equipment in the amount varying according to the period of implementation of the activity.
- As in Templates II, the condition of supporting at least 10 pupils and purchasing at least 10 mobile devices applies.
- The activity can be selected up to the value reaching half of the maximum amount of financial support for the given subject.



Thanks to this activity more than 3500 schools and school facilities have purchased a total of more than 57,000 computers or tablets in Templates II. Almost 619 mil CZK were used for this activity.

Other optional activities:

- Personnel support: school assistant, special pedagogue, psychologist, social pedagogue, nanny for nursery schools, school career counsellor
- Further training of teachers: tandem teaching, sharing experience through study visits and a new template for internships abroad
- Project day out of school, support for the use of ICT in education, clubs for pupils, tutoring pupils, professionally focused thematic meetings and cooperation with parents
